

The Cheering Voices ODA QI Project Timeline

Pre-Program

- Registration form completed and submitted to Cheering For Charity
 - Dates selected for and entered into calendar
 - Staff Lead/Voices Resources appointed to participate in the assessment process
 - Information regarding program is shared with staff, residents and families
 - Staff support designated for participants (minimum of 12 - maximum of 40)
 - Staff (maximum 12) attends required Alzheimer's 101 two hour training class
 - Signed HIPAA forms and Consent/Media Releases are obtained from residents and attendees
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One Week Prior

- Each participants' diagnoses, current medications, and recent cognitive ax results are provided to The Cheering Voices clinician
 - Clinician reviews the information with collaboration from facility staff lead
 - NPI Questionnaire is completed by staff lead/ Voice Resources on each resident's closest caregiver and family member
 - Cheering clinician enters the participants into the Results Measurement Database
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Weeks #1 through Week #6

- Residents are assembled by facility staff at the appointed time and space
 - Cheering Voices Musicians and CDP Facilitators and clinician(s) arrive early to setup
 - Live musical interactive therapy session takes place for one hour each week
 - Resident observation is performed by Cheering for Charity clinician during each session
 - Results are entered into the weekly QOL assessment tool
 - Final music performance on week 6 includes refreshments and a visit from The Cheering for Charity Foundation's Cheering Closet volunteers who bring small gifts and personal items for the nursing home residents
 - All data is finalized and entered into the Results Measurement Database
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Week #9

- NPI Questionnaire is conducted week 9 by facility DON/ADON/staff lead on each resident's closest caregiver and family member
 - Each participants' diagnoses, current PRN medications, and recent cognitive ax results are provided to The Cheering Voices clinician
 - All data is finalized and entered into the Results Measurement Database
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Week #12

- A final site visit is made at week #12 by Cheering for Charity Clinical Director at a mutually agreed upon time for review of outcomes, sharing of reports and the certificate of completion is presented to the facility.
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Post Program

Expected evidence of participation in the project to demonstrate compliance with the ODA Nursing Home Quality Initiative will include the following documents provided by The Cheering Voices:

- Copy of signed participation agreement and signed certificate of completion of the project
 - Copies of baseline resident assessment data, and QOL Totals assessment forms
